What's Hot in Sinks & Faucets

- 1. LENOVA has launched a line of solid-brass kitchen faucets in four styles with high-arc spouts. The no-lead brass is extremely resistant to rust and corrosion, and the Kerox ceramic cartridges offer a drip-free performance. The pulldown faucets each feature single-lever control, two-function sprayers and a spout with a 360-degree swivel so the user can access the entire sink. Each of the faucets is available in chrome or polished nickel and they range in price from \$250 to \$395. Ienovacroup.com
- 2. CALIFORNIA FAUCETS has added the Squeeze Handle Sprayer to its kitchen faucet collection. The lever is easy to use and features a powerful spray function to clean the dirtiest dishes. The solid-brass sprayhead is insulated so it is not too hot to the touch, it features a docking system to make sure it stays in place when it needs to, and it is available for most pulldown faucets (shown is the Corsano). Pricing starts at \$1,245 for the Corsano Pulldown Prep/Bar Faucet with Squeeze Handle Sprayer in polished chrome. Californiafaucets.com
- 3. CEA's LUTEZIA collection of bathroom taps was designed by Jean-Michel Wilmotte and features soft and rounded lines. Its stainless-steel offering is available in satin, polished and in all of the company's special finishes, which include black diamond, bronze, copper and light gold. The washbasin spouts have water-saving aerators, and the tub fillers feature a flow straightener without flow restriction. The LTZO2 wall-mounted dual-handle mixer shown with spout in black diamond is \$4,620. www.ceadesign.it
- 4. The Central Park West bathroom collection by Robert A.M. Stern Architects for KALLISTA is a brassware series inspired by early 20th-century design. It features a variety of sink and bath faucets, shower fixtures and complementary accessories, as well as a shower door handle pull, towel bar and handle escutcheon. The sink faucets are available in an elongated U-shaped design with low and tall spout heights, a graceful gooseneck (shown) and a sleek wall-mount style, and an engraved "H" and "C" are on the front of each bonnet. MSRP for the item shown is \$1,165. www.kallista.com
- 5. The Urban Collection of sinks from HASTINGS TILE & BATH is offered in integrated, pedestal and basin units. The Morris Solid-Surface Vessel basins (shown with an HPL cover tray in Pulpis Chiaro) are available in matte or gloss white, and the drain cover tray is available in all HPL and Fenix finishes to coordinate with the countertops. The Morris basins start at \$1,674. Hastingstilebath.com
- 6. The Marnie Basin from LONDON BASIN CO. was inspired by the colors of India and features a floral pattern in pinks, blues and greens set against a bright yellow. Marnie offers a flat base and is shown here with the new Oscar wall-mounted tap. The price for the basin is around \$1,370, and the tap is \$615. Londonbasincompany.com
- 7. BLANCO has introduced the VINTERRA farmhouse sink collection, the company's more minimalist take on the apron-front sink with a flush-mount installation integrated into the countertop. The collection includes two models the 30-in. Super Single (shown here in coal black) and the 33-in. Equal Double and the apron-front height is 6.5 inches, while the bowl depth is 9 inches. VINTERRA is made from the brand's SILGRANIT material, which is nonporous and offers the Hygienic Plus surface. Prices range from \$1,399 to \$1,649. blanco.com
- 8. ELKAY's Crosstown stainless-steel farmhouse sink features an interchangeable apron, which is available in a variety of materials and colors and can be easily removed and switched out. On select Elkay sinks, Aqua Divide is a low center divider that makes it easy to wash large items over both bowls. The sinks are made of a material that minimizes sound and vibration, and an offset drain provides more usable space on the bottom and in the cabinet below. The Crosstown sinks range from \$750 to \$1,149, and the aprons range from \$250 to \$449. Elkay.com
